History Of The Ostrich



Ancient Egyptians trained the Ostrich to pull carts. Over 2,000 years ago, the *Egyptian Queen Arsinoe* rode an Ostrich with a saddle. Teams of Ostriches were sometimes used in Rome to pull the chariots in races. Roman generals decorated their battle helmets with Ostrich feathers as a sign of distinction and leadership. Their wives wore Ostrich plumes for royal decoration, and rode Ostrich at public functions. Ostrich eggshells have also been discovered in Chinese caves that were occupied by humans 25,000 years ago.

Evidence suggests that early bushmen in South Africa also hunted the large birds for meat, used Ostrich eggshells for water containers and to make decorative beads. Ancient Ostrich drawings, discovered in Egyptian tombs, suggest that they were somewhat domesticated by the Egyptians. The Ostrich was the emblem of *Themis, the Egyptian Goddess of Truth and Justice*. Pharaohs and their families were among the elite that could possess hand-held Ostrich feather fans.

Ostrich oil was used as a cosmetic, and as a treatment for rheumatoid pain, by the ancient Egyptians and Romans.
